1. The inventory at the beginning date of the sale.
2. The quantity of each item sold each day.
3. The quantity of each item remaining unsold at the close of each day's business and at the closing date of the sale.

In addition, books and records as prescribed by the Department of Banking and Finance shall be kept and shall be made available to the Tax Collector upon request.

CHECK LIST FOR APPLICANT FIRE / OR GOING OUT OF BUSINESS SALE

- (1) Do you have a current inventory list?
- (2) Do you have a copy of the proposed advertisement?
- (3) Do you have your business licenses to turn in with your application?
- (4) The Tax Collector's fee is set by law (see section 559.23 F.S.) The \$50.00 fee must be in the form of cash, bank money order or other certified funds.
- (5) Do you understand your responsibility for keeping the required books and records and making such records available for inspection?
- (6) Do you understand your responsibilities of keeping the inventory listing current?
- (7) Do you understand that any taxes owed must be paid prior to the issuance of a permit?
- (8) The permit can be issued for a period of not more than 60 consecutive days including Sundays and holidays.
- (9) The permit authorizes only one type of sale at the location shown on the permit.
- (10) Only the goods included in the inventory furnished by you and attached to the permit may be offered for sale.
- (11) The permit shall not be transferred or assigned
- (12) Sale must be in strict conformity with advertisement.
