



IDENTIFICATION CARDS FOR CHILDREN AGE 5 & OLDER

ID cards include your child's picture, height, sex, address and date of birth.

The information contained in your child's ID card will be accessible to law enforcement through **D.A.V.I.D. (Driver and Vehicle Information Database)** in case of an emergency.

You may obtain an ID card for **\$31.25** from the Osceola County Tax Collector's main office located at:

In order to obtain an ID card your child, you must present one primary and one secondary form of identification.

The following documents are acceptable as primary identification: (Photocopies of the primary identification documents are unacceptable.)

- An original or certified copy of your child's birth certificate issued through Vital Statistics.
- A U.S. Passport
- Naturalization papers (Issued from INS)

The following documents are acceptable as secondary identification:

- Social Security Card
